

United Way of Forsyth County YOUR IMPACT IN 2020

- United Way of Forsyth County provided more than \$60,000 in emergency assistance and supplies to residents during the 2020 pandemic
- Bald Ridge Lodge and Jesse's House provided a safe, home-like environment for over 51 boys and girls
 where they received therapeutic service to aid in the education and development
- Literacy Forsyth provided GED classes to over 747 students
- 123 CASA volunteers advocated for 205 children and continued to serve 100% of the children in foster care
 in Forsyth County as appointed by the Juvenile Court Judges
- Georgia Highlands Medical Services provided medical services to 19,633 patients, of which 49% were uninsured
- Mentor Me served 508 children and youth in 2020 using virtual programs. These children and teens are vulnerable to the uncertainty brough on by the pandemic and rely on these programs
- SISU Integrated Learning serves typical and atypical students aged 6 weeks—6 years old. In 2020 they provided \$757,913 in assistance for charity care, scholarships, etc to 249 students served in the classroom intervention program
- Scholarships for two adults with disabilities to attend Creative Enterprises twice a week, providing social skills, life skills, educational programs and job placement assistance
- Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts provided virtual and in person meetings and camps to 3,839 youth
